

U.S. Launches Production at Deepwater Shenandoah Field, Signaling New Momentum in Gulf of Mexico

The United States has officially commenced production at the Shenandoah offshore oil and gas field in the Gulf of Mexico, marking one of the most significant new developments in deepwater U.S. exploration in recent years. The announcement was made by Beacon Offshore which leads the project alongside Energy, **Navitas** Petroleum partners and HEO Deepwater.

Located approximately 160 miles south of New Orleans in Walker Ridge Block 51, the Shenandoah field is situated in water depths of



over 5,800 feet. The field was discovered in 2009, but commercial development had been delayed due to technical and economic challenges. Now, with robust oil prices and a renewed industry focus on maximizing domestic resources, the project has finally moved into the production phase.

Phase 1 of the Shenandoah development is expected to produce around 100,000 barrels of oil per day (bpd) at peak, with potential for future expansion. The facility utilizes a floating production system (FPS) and is tied into preexisting Gulf infrastructure, enhancing commercial viability. The development also represents a major investment in American energy independence, as well as in high-pressure reservoir engineering.

For oil and gas professionals, Shenandoah's startup is significant for several reasons:

- It highlights renewed investor and regulatory confidence in deepwater U.S. offshore development.
- The project incorporates next-generation subsea systems capable of handling ultra-high pressures, setting a new technological benchmark.
- It signals a potential revival of large-scale exploration and production (E&P) activities in the Gulf, especially as smaller independents like Beacon lead where supermajors once dominated.

Energy analysts view Shenandoah as a symbol of the U.S. industry's resilience and adaptability. Despite increasing scrutiny on offshore operations from environmental regulators, the field's activation reaffirms the Gulf of Mexico's strategic importance in the global energy mix.

Further expansions and tie-back projects may follow, providing new opportunities for offshore services, engineering, and midstream integration in the coming years.





U.S. Considers Limited Chevron **Entry** into Venezuela, Signal to Energy Markets

The U.S. administration is preparing to issue limited authorizations allowing Chevron—and possibly other oil firms—to resume restricted operations in Venezuela in coordination with statecontrolled PDVSA. This represents a notable shift from earlier policy that revoked all U.S. energy licenses in February 2025.

If finalized, these permissions would enable Chevron to pay contractors, import essential equipment, and engage in oil-for-fuel swaps, while prohibiting direct revenue or royalties flowing to the Maduro regime. A recent prisoner exchange involving 10 U.S. citizens and over 200 Venezuelan deportees appears to have catalyzed the policy recalibration.

Chevron shares surged to their highest in months following the news, reaching approximately \$155.90 per share on renewed investor optimism. Analysts estimate a cautious restart could add up to 200,000 barrels per day (bpd) within six to twelve months—enough to modestly boost Venezuela's underperforming production.

What's at Stake for Oil & Gas Professionals:

Operational Restart: Chevron's return could reactivate idled joint-venture infrastructure and service agreements in Venezuela's heavy-oil field.

For energy firms, the move signals that Washington is prioritizing energy security and market diversification, albeit within stringent oversight. Clearing procedural and legal uncertainties remains key as this unfolds.













OPEC+ Likely to Maintain August Production Increase

OPEC+ has formally endorsed a significant production hike of 548,000 barrels per day (bpd) to begin in August 2025, raising output targets above the 411,000 bpd monthly increases in May, June, and July.

This move marks a deeper phase in OPEC+'s strategic shift away from policy-driven supply cuts toward reclaiming market share. It follows the unwinding of over 1.9 million bpd since April—a large portion of the 2.2 mb/d voluntary cuts initiated in 2024.

Eight key members—Saudi Arabia, Russia, UAE, Kuwait, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Algeria, and Oman —are driving the increase. They cited a stable global economic outlook and abnormally low oil inventories as motivations for the move.

Market & Strategic Reaction

Crude prices initially dipped, with Brent trading around \$68.70 and WTI near \$66.98 postannouncement. However, sentiment rebounded as stronger U.S. holiday demand and inventory draws—plus signs of sustained economic activity—offset supply-side pressure.

Analysts at ING warn the expanded supply could tilt the market toward oversupply in late 2025, pointing to declining spare capacity and rising U.S. shale competition. Goldman Sachs forecasts an additional 550,000 bpd rise in September, which would complete the return of trimmed volumes and bring total output from the eight key members to roughly 33.2 mb/d, with Saudi Arabia providing more than 60% of the incremental barrels.









U.S. Crude Draws and Russian Export Cuts Lift **Prices**

Global oil benchmarks climbed today as U.S. crude inventories dropped by 3.2 million barrels, well above analysts' consensus of a 1.6 million-barrel decline. This drawdown, which brought total stocks to 419 million barrels, added immediate upward pressure to the market.

At the same time, reports surfaced that Russia plans to restrict gasoline exports in August and September, limiting sales to countries outside a select group of allies—raising concerns about tighter supply flows ahead.

By market close, Brent crude had risen approximately 1% to \$69.18/bbl, while WTI gained 1.2% to settle at \$66.03/bbl, rebounding from earlier losses tied to news about Chevron's planned reentry into Venezuela.

Analysts noted that the combination of stronger-than-expected U.S. draws and looming Russian export restrictions created a bullish backdrop, counterbalancing broader global trade uncertainties and oversupply fears. Janiv Shah of Rystad commented that these fundamental signals helped reinforce price resilience near the \$65–64 range support levels.

The recent U.S. crude inventory draw and Russia's export curbs have tightened short-term supply, supporting a rebound in oil prices. These developments highlight the sensitivity of markets to both domestic and geopolitical supply shifts. Energy professionals should monitor upcoming inventory reports and Russian policy moves closely.

International Energy Agency (IEA) Reports Global **Demand Growth Slows**

The International Energy Agency (IEA) in its August Oil Market Report confirmed a slowdown in global oil demand growth, projecting an increase of just 700,000 barrels per day (bpd) in 2025—the lowest annual rise since 2009, excluding the Covid crash year. Emerging and developing economies are driving marginal gains, whereas demand in OECD markets continues to contract.

Breakdown of Demand Trends

- Growth slowed significantly from the 990,000 bpd recorded in Q1 to just 550,000 bpd in Q2
- Forecasts for 2026 remain modest at 720,000 bpd, reflecting persistent headwinds from trade uncertainties and rising EV adoptionChina and India continue to show mixed performance.
- China's consumption is plateauing due to NEV expansion and rail infrastructure, while India remains a relatively stronger growth engine.

Supply vs Demand: Imbalance Looms

- Supply growth is far outpacing demand, with global output rising by 2.1 mb/d in 2025, partly due to accelerated OPEC+ production and resilient non-OPEC+ output.
- This widening gap is expected to lead to rising inventory levels—estimated at averaging 720,000 bpd stock builds during late 2025 and Q1 2026

The IEA's cautious stance underscores a major structural shift: the deceleration of oil consumption growth as electrification, EV penetration, and economic uncertainty converge. Meanwhile, increasing supply—particularly from major producers—fuels a surplus that may continue to weigh on industry profitability through 2026.










Global Emissions Standard Stalled - Shell withdrew support

A major initiative to establish global net-zero emissions guidelines for the oil and gas sector has hit a critical setback. Key industry players including Shell, Aker BP, and Enbridge—have exited the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) advisory group following proposals requiring companies to halt development of new oil and gas fields by 2027 as a condition for netzero certification.

these departures, **SBTi** In response announced a formal pause on the development of its oil and gas standard—citing "capacity considerations" as the reason, while denying any direct link to industry influence. The delay leaves the sector without a unified framework to link climate ambition with operational limits and production strategy.



Why This Matters

- Policy credibility at risk: Without a binding sector standard, independent climate trackers question major operators' consistency and credibility in aligning with a 1.5°C pathway.
- Divergence over exploration limits: Industry concerns center on a perceived mismatch between draft proposals and the realities of energy demand and social equity—especially the ban on new field development.
- Widening investor scrutiny: The pause may impact investor sentiment and ESG ratings, as financial institutions increasingly demand transparency and enforcement toward climatealigned transformation.

Broader Climate & Emissions Context

Meanwhile, the International Energy Agency reports methane emissions remain alarmingly high, with only 5% of global oil and gas output operating at near-zero methane thresholds underscoring that even operational emissions targets (Scopes 1 & 2) remain far from unified standards. Analysts warn that voluntary commitments and fragmented standards may not suffice to curb warming within globally accepted limits.

The stalling of the global emissions standard weakens momentum toward unified climate accountability in the oil and gas sector. This may hinder efforts to align industry practices with international decarbonization goals.









Carnarvon Takes Stake in Aussie Gas Explorer Strike **Energy**

Carnarvon Energy (ASX: CVN) has committed up to A\$89 million (~US\$58 million) to acquire a 19.9% stake in Strike Energy (ASX: STX), betting on the onshore Permian-aged gas potential of the Perth Basin. The deal is structured in two tranches: approximately A\$52 million (~13%) at A\$0.12/share now, with a second tranche of up to A\$37 million contingent on shareholder approval in September 2025.



Upon completion of the first tranche, Carnarvon will gain rights to nominate a board member, provided its holding stays above 10% for at least two months.

The capital injection will support Strike's growth roadmap, including advancing the West Erregulla gas project, completing the 85 MW South Erregulla peaking power station, life extension of the Walvering domestic gas field, and maturation of other development and exploration assets in the Perth Basin.

Key Insights for Industry Professionals

- Capital & Balance Sheet Reinforcement: Strike gains financial capacity to bring core gas projects toward FID phases, while Carnarvon retains flexibility to pursue its Bedout exploration and Dorado JV ambitions.
- Shareholder Discomfort: The entry price (A\$0.12) represented a ~20% discount to Strike's recent trading average, triggering a ~15% immediate drop in STX's share price; some investors questioned the dilution and pricing impact.

Why It Matters

- For upstream developers, the deal exemplifies how regional E&P firms can be leveraged to deliver capital-efficient growth via strategic partnerships.
- For investors, it reflects a pivot toward gas assets and regional energy security play amid Australian policy shifts and east coast domestic gas constraints.
- For service providers, upcoming milestones across Erregulla, South Erregulla, and Walyering signal multiple engineering, drilling, and EPC opportunities in the near term.

Carnarvon's strategic stake in Strike Energy signals growing industry confidence in Western Australia's onshore gas potential amid shifting regional energy priorities.






